Section 3. (1) The Board of Medicine shall adopt rules to <u>establish requirements that ensure the safe and effective</u> <u>delivery of pediatric surgical care in ambulatory surgical</u> <u>centers in accordance with the American College of Surgeons'</u> <u>evidence-based standards for optimal pediatric care. The rules</u> must establish minimum standards for pediatric-specific patient

12	(a) Surgical risk assessment.
13	(b) Anesthesiology.
14	(c) Resuscitation.
15	(d) Transfer agreements.
16	(e) Training and certification of pediatric health care
17	providers.
