- (c) A person who, before the effective date of this section through any public or private resettlement assistance program for foreign refugees or immigrants, engaged in assisting with the entry into or resettlement in the state of a foreign refugee or immigrant, within 90 days after the effective date of this act, shall submit to the department the personal identifying information of each such foreign refugee or immigrant currently residing in this state, unless the foreign refugee or immigrant was born in the western hemisphere.
- (d)1. The department shall conduct a background screening of a foreign refugee or immigrant within 15 days after receipt of his or her personal identifying information pursuant to paragraph (a) or paragraph (b), or within 30 days after receipt pursuant to paragraph (c), or within 90 days for any foreign refugee or immigrant continuously residing in the state since January 1, 2011.
