Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 1002.391, Florida Statutes, to read:

1002.391 Auditory-oral education programs.

- (4) Notwithstanding s. 1011.62, a child who is deaf or hard of hearing and who is enrolled in an auditory-oral education program in this state shall:
- (a) Have seven special consideration points added annually by the child's school district to the total score of all domains on his or her matrix of services until the child is no longer enrolled in the program or turns 7 years of age, whichever occurs first.
- (b) Be eligible for auditory-oral education grants until the child is 7 years of age if the child is enrolled in a program that serves multiple counties, including rural and underserved areas. The school that offers the program must offer solely auditory-oral education programs and must have a supervisor and faculty who are certified as listening and spoken language specialists.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
