Section 4. Subsection (5) of section 316.235, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.235 Additional lighting equipment.-

(5) A bus, as defined in s. 316.003(3), may be equipped with a deceleration lighting system that which cautions following vehicles that the bus is slowing, is preparing to

Such lighting system shall consist of two 12 red or amber lights mounted in horizontal alignment on the rear 13 of the vehicle at or near the vertical centerline of the 14 vehicle, no greater than 12 inches apart, not higher than the lower edge of the rear window or, if the vehicle has no rear 15 16 window, not higher than 72 inches from the ground. Such lights 17 shall be visible from a distance of not less than 300 feet to 18 the rear in normal sunlight. Lights are permitted to light and flash during deceleration, braking, or standing and idling of 19 20 the bus.
