WHEREAS, the incidence of uterine fibroids among African-American women is the greatest of any race, estimated to be three to four times greater when compared to Caucasian women and three to five times greater than the general population, and

WHEREAS, as many as three out of four women will have uterine fibroids during their lives, and up to 80 percent of women by age 50 will be affected by uterine fibroids, and

WHEREAS, uterine fibroids may cause significant morbidity through their presence in the uterus and pelvic cavity, and benign tumors are a significant cause of pelvic pain, abnormal uterine bleeding, and reproductive dysfunction, and
