5 Section 22. Section 893.30, Florida Statutes, is created

9 (1) This section may be cited as the "Victoria Siegel  
10 Controlled Substance Safety Education and Awareness Act."

11 (2) The department shall develop a written pamphlet  
12 relating to controlled substances which includes educational  
13 information about the following:

14        (a) Precautions regarding the use of pain management  
15 prescriptions.

16        (b) The potential for misuse and abuse of controlled  
17 substances by adults and children.

18        (c) The risk of controlled substance dependency and  
19 addiction.

20        (d) The proper storage and disposal of controlled  
21 substances.

22        (e) Controlled substance addiction support and treatment  
23 resources.

24        (f) Telephone helplines and website links that provide  
25 counseling and emergency assistance for individuals dealing with  
26 substance abuse.

27        (3) The department shall encourage health care providers,  
28 including, but not limited to, hospitals, county health  
29 departments, physicians, and nurses, to disseminate and display  
30 information about controlled substance safety, including, but  
31 not limited to, the pamphlet created pursuant to subsection (2).

32        (4) The department shall encourage consumers to discuss  
33 the risks of controlled substance use with their health care  
34 providers.

35        (5) The State Surgeon General shall make publicly  
36 available, by posting on the department's website, the pamphlet  
37 created pursuant to subsection (2) and additional resources as  
38 appropriate.
