(9) Any person who, because of mental illness, intellectual disability, senility, or other physical or mental incapacity, is permanently incapable of caring for himself or herself may be permanently excused from jury service upon request if the

request is accompanied by a written statement to that effect from a physician licensed pursuant to chapter 458 or chapter
