- (2) Upon a recipient's request for a fourth replacement card within a 12-month period, and any subsequent request thereafter, the Department of Children and Families shall schedule an interview for the recipient with a fraud investigator and eligibility expert before a replacement card is issued.
- (3) If a recipient fails to appear at an interview scheduled under subsection (2), the Department of Children and Families shall terminate the recipient's benefits within 10 days, unless expressly prohibited by federal law.
