An act relating to controlled substances; amending s. 893.13, F.S.; requiring a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment for specified violations committed in a dwelling; amending s. 893.135, F.S.; creating the offense of trafficking in synthetic drugs; providing specified offenses involving 250 grams or more of specified controlled substances; requiring specified mandatory minimum terms of imprisonment and fines based on the quantity involved in the offense; amending s. 921.0022, F.S.; adding specified trafficking provisions established in s. 893.135, F.S., to the offense severity ranking chart of the Criminal Punishment Code and reclassifying the severity level of specified offenses; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 893.13, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

893.13 Prohibited acts; penalties.-

- (1) (a) Except as authorized by this chapter and chapter 499, a person may not sell, manufacture, or deliver, or possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, a controlled substance. A person who violates this provision with respect to:
- 1. A controlled substance named or described in s. 893.03(1)(a), (1)(b), (1)(d), (2)(a), (2)(b), or (2)(c)4. commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in

be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 3

2. A controlled substance named or described in s. 893.03(1)(c), (2)(c)1., (2)(c)2., (2)(c)3., (2)(c)5., (2)(c)6., (2)(c)7., (2)(c)8., (2)(c)9., (3), or (4) commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

3. A controlled substance named or described in s. 893.03(5) commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

Section 2. Paragraph (m) is added to subsection (1) of section 893.135, Florida Statutes, to read:

893.135 Trafficking; mandatory sentences; suspension or reduction of sentences; conspiracy to engage in trafficking.—

- (1) Except as authorized in this chapter or in chapter 499 and notwithstanding the provisions of s. 893.13:
- (m) 1. Except as provided in subparagraph 2. or subparagraph 3., a person who knowingly sells, purchases, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, 250 grams or more of a controlled substance specified in s. 893.03(1)(c)46.-50., 114.-142., 151.-159., or 166.-173., or any mixture containing those substances, commits a felony of the first degree, which shall be known as "trafficking in synthetic drugs," punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. If the quantity involved:
 - a. Is 250 grams or more, but less than 500 grams, such

person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 3 years and ordered to pay a fine of \$25,000.

- b. Is 500 grams or more, but less than 1,000 grams, such person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 7 years and ordered to pay a fine of \$50,000.
- c. Is 1,000 grams or more, but less than 30 kilograms, such person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 15 years and ordered to pay a fine of \$200,000.
- d. Is 30 kilograms or more, such person shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of 25 years and ordered to pay a fine of \$750,000.
- 2. A person who knowingly sells, purchases, manufactures, delivers, or brings into this state, or who is knowingly in actual or constructive possession of, 30 kilograms or more of a controlled substance described in s. 893.03(1)(c)46.-50., 114.-142., 151.-159., or 166.-173., or any mixture containing those substances, commits the first degree felony of trafficking in synthetic drugs. A person who is convicted of the first degree felony of trafficking in synthetic drugs under this subparagraph shall be punished by life imprisonment and is ineligible for any form of discretionary early release except pardon or executive clemency or conditional medical release under s. 947.149. However, if the court determines that, in addition to committing any act specified in this paragraph:
- a. The person intentionally killed an individual or counseled, commanded, induced, procured, or caused the intentional killing of an individual and such killing was the result; or
 - b. The person's conduct in committing the act led to a
