(5) Senior citizens who are 65 years of age or older shall receive a 25-percent discount on annual entrance passes purchased in Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The department shall report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives the total number of participants no later than June 30, 2017. This subsection expires July 1, 2017.

Section 2. For Fiscal Year 2016-2017, the sum of \$200,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund is appropriated to the Department of Environmental Protection for the purpose of offsetting the loss of revenue to the State Park Trust Fund as a result of the 25-percent discount provided in the act.
