Section 1. Section 768.139, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

768.139 Damages in actions against veterinarians for the death of a companion animal.—

(1) For the purpose of this section, the term:

(a) "Companion animal" means a domesticated animal that is in a close daily relationship with its owner.

(b) "Veterinarian" means an individual who practices in veterinary medicine as regulated under chapter 474.

(2) An owner, in any action against a veterinarian for the death of his or her companion animal which resulted from a veterinarian's negligence or recklessness, is entitled to damages for loss of companionship.
