6 Section 38. Active duty soldiers.—

7 (1) Upon action by the Federal Government providing each  
8 Florida veteran a veteran's identification card allowing the  
9 veteran to access health care services from any licensed Florida  
10 health care provider, fully paid for by the Federal Government,  
11 the tax levied under chapter 212, Florida Statutes, may not be  
12 collected during the period from 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2016,  
13 through 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2020, for retail purchases of

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14 tangible personal property made by a soldier on active duty, as  
15 defined in s. 250.01, for personal use.

16 (2) To be eligible for the tax exemption, the active duty  
17 soldier must provide identification verifying the active duty  
18 status.

19 (3) The Department of Revenue may, and all conditions are  
20 deemed met to, adopt emergency rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1)  
21 and 120.54, Florida Statutes, to administer this section.
