Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 196.1973, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

196.1973 Exemption for property used for a nonprofit blood establishment.-Property used exclusively to operate or directly support the activities of a nonprofit blood establishment is determined to be used for a charitable purpose as defined in s. 196.012(7) and is exempt from ad valorem taxation within the purview of s. 3, Art. VII, State Constitution. It is declared to be the intent of the Legislature that this section implements the ad valorem tax exemption authorized in s. 3(a), Art. VII of the State Constitution for the purpose of granting such exemption to a nonprofit blood establishment. As used in this section, the term "blood establishment" has the same meaning as defined in s. 381.06014(1)(a) or as subsequently amended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
