A bill to be entitled

An act relating to law enforcement officer training; amending s. 943.1716, F.S.; expanding the instruction that the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission requires of a law enforcement officer to include interpersonal skills relating to racial minorities; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 943.1716, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

943.1716 Continued employment training relating to diverse populations.—The commission shall by rule require that each officer receive, as part of the 40 hours of required instruction for continued employment or appointment as an officer, instruction in the subject of interpersonal skills relating to diverse populations and racial minorities, with an emphasis on the awareness of cultural differences, how racial bias impacts interactions with racial minorities, and ways to combat inherent biases.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
