Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section 95.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

95.11 Limitations other than for the recovery of real property.—Actions other than for recovery of real property shall be commenced as follows:

- (3) WITHIN FOUR YEARS.-
- (c) An action founded on the design, planning, or construction of an improvement to real property, with the time running from the date of actual possession by the owner, the date of the issuance of a certificate of occupancy, the date of abandonment of construction if not completed, or the date of completion or termination of the contract between the professional engineer, registered architect, or licensed contractor and his or her employer, whichever date is latest; except that, when the action involves a latent defect, the time runs from the time the defect is discovered or should have been discovered with the exercise of due diligence. In any event, the action must be commenced within 10 years after the date of actual possession by the owner, the date of the issuance of a certificate of occupancy, the date of abandonment of construction if not completed, or the date of completion or termination of the contract between the professional engineer, registered architect, or licensed contractor and his or her

employer, whichever date is latest. Completion of the contract
shall be the last date the professional engineer, registered
architect, or licensed contractor furnishes labor, services, or
materials, not including labor, services, or materials relating
to correction of deficiencies in such engineer's, architect's,
or contractor's previously performed work or materials supplied.
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
