Section 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Protection shall evaluate the potential for using the Inland Protection Trust Fund to respond to the damage or potential damage to underground storage tank systems caused by ethanol or biodiesel. The department shall issue a request for information regarding the potential for damage to underground petroleum systems by ethanol or biodiesel and the potential costs of implementing and



maintaining a program to address such damage. The department shall compile this information into a report, which shall be submitted to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor by December 15, 2017.

- (2) For the 2017-2018 fiscal year, the sum of \$25,000 in nonrecurring funds from the Inland Protection Trust Fund is provided to fund the program provided in subsection (1).
  - (3) This section expires December 30, 2017.
