Section 743.067, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 743.067 Certified unaccompanied homeless youths.-(1) For purposes of this section, the term an "certified unaccompanied homeless youth" means a minor who is a homeless

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child or youth or an unaccompanied youth, as those terms are

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11	defined in 42 U.S.C. s. 11434a., who has been certified as
12	homeless or unaccompanied by is an individual who is 16 years of
13	age or older and is:
14	(a) A school district homeless liaison;
15	(a) Found by a school district's liaison for homeless
16	children and youths to be an unaccompanied homeless youth
17	eligible for services pursuant to the McKinney-Vento Homeless
18	Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. ss. 11431-11435; or
19	(b) Believed to qualify as an unaccompanied homeless youth,
20	as that term is defined in the McKinney-Vento Homeless
21	Assistance Act, by:
22	(b) 1. The director of an emergency shelter program funded
23	by the United States Department of Housing and Urban
24	Development, or the director's designee; or
25	(c) 2. The director of a runaway or homeless youth basic
26	center or transitional living program funded by the United
27	States Department of Health and Human Services, or the
28	director's designee <u>.</u> +
29	- 3. A clinical social worker licensed under chapter 491; or
30	4. A circuit court.
31	(2) (a) The Office on Homelessness within the Department of
32	Children and Families shall develop a standardized form that
33	must be used by the entities specified in subsection (1) to
34	certify qualifying unaccompanied homeless youth. The form must
35	include the circumstances that qualify the youth; the date the
36	youth was certified; the name, title, and signature of the
37	certifying individual; and a citation to this section. A minor
38	who qualifies as an unaccompanied homeless youth shall be issued
39	a written certificate documenting his or her status by the

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40	appropriate individual as provided in subsection (1). The
41	certificate shall be issued on the official letterhead
42	stationery of the person making the determination and shall
43	include the date of the finding, a citation to this section, and
44	the signature of the individual making the finding.
45	(b) A certified unaccompanied homeless youth may use the
46	completed form to apply at no charge for an identification card
47	issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
48	pursuant to s. 322.051(9).
49	(c) A health care provider may accept the written
50	certificate or identification card as proof of the minor's
51	status as <u>a certified</u> an unaccompanied homeless youth and may
52	keep a copy of the certificate or identification card in the
53	youth's medical file.
54	(3) <u>A certified</u> an unaccompanied homeless youth may:
55	(a) Petition the circuit court to have the disabilities of
56	nonage removed under s. 743.015. The youth shall qualify as a
57	person not required to prepay costs and fees as provided in s.
58	57.081. The court shall advance the cause on the calendar.
59	(b) Notwithstanding s. 394.4625(1), consent to medical,
60	dental, psychological, substance abuse, and surgical diagnosis
61	and treatment, including preventative care and care by a
62	facility licensed under chapter 394, chapter 395, or chapter 397
63	and any forensic medical examination for the purpose of
64	investigating any felony offense under chapter 784, chapter 787,
65	chapter 794, chapter 800, or chapter 827, for:
66	1. Himself or herself; or
67	2. His or her child, if the <u>certified</u> unaccompanied
68	homeless youth is unmarried, is the parent of the child, and has

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69	actual custody of the child.
