A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the City of Jacksonville, Duval County; providing exceptions to general law; providing that a business licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises may sell such beverages for consumption off premises during certain events when such business is located within or contiguous to a certain district; providing definitions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of general law to the contrary, a business located inside of or contiguous to the A. Philip Randolph Entertainment District which is licensed to sell alcoholic beverages to patrons for consumption on the licensed premises may sell such beverages to patrons for consumption off the licensed premises during a special event.
 - (2) As used in this act:
- (a) "A. Philip Randolph Entertainment District" means the area defined in section 191.201 of the City of Jacksonville

 Ordinance Code, as amended.
- (b) "Special event" means a special event as defined in section 191.202 of the City of Jacksonville Ordinance Code, as amended.
