An act relating to crime reports; amending s. 943.05, F.S.; requiring the Criminal Justice Information Program to submit an annual report to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; specifying the data the program must include in the report; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (i) is added to subsection (2) of section 943.05, Florida Statutes, to read:
- 943.05 Criminal Justice Information Program; duties; crime reports.—
 - (2) The program shall:
- (i) Establish, implement, and maintain a system for preparing and submitting an annual report to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Each report must include statistics for the previous calendar year on crime in this state, including, but not limited to, the types of crimes reported, numbers of offenders, arrests, victims, and data on gun-related homicides.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
