(2) This section shall take effect July 1, 2017, if CS/CS/CS/HB 581 or similar legislation relating to an asset verification service for food assistance programs is not adopted during the same legislative session or an extension thereof and fails to become a law.

Section 11. (1) For fiscal year 2017-2018, the sum of \$500,000 in nonrecurring funds is appropriated from the Welfare Transition Trust Fund to the Department of Economic Opportunity for distribution to CareerSource Florida, Inc., to contract for development of a program to serve temporary cash assistance work registrants with significant barriers to employment pursuant to this act, including, but not limited to, providing the initial program design, evaluation design, training curricula development and delivery of training, implementation oversight, development of informational materials for participants, and technical assistance; and for distribution to selected local workforce boards for startup expenses incurred by vendors implementing the program, including, but not limited to, information technology updates, program coordination, and staff training. Case management and direct services for all temporary cash assistance recipients shall be provided within current resources.
