## **ANALYST COMMENT**

This appropriation provided \$15 million in nonrecurring funds from general revenue to Florida International University for construction of the School of International & Public Affairs building. There are no prior appropriations for this initiative. The project was beyond the three-year priority list submitted by the Board of Governors. This initiative was funded in the Senate General Appropriations bill.
