Section 22. Subject to federal approval of the application to be a site for the Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE), the Agency for Health Care Administration shall contract with an organization located in Miami-Dade County that owns and operates primary care medical centers in South Florida. The organization shall leverage its existing community-based



11 care providers to provide PACE services to frail elders who 12 reside in Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach Counties. The 13 organization is exempt from the requirements of chapter 641, 14 Florida Statutes. The agency, in consultation with the 15 Department of Elderly Affairs and subject to an appropriation of 16 funds by the Legislature, shall approve up to 300 initial 17 enrollees in the PACE site established by the organization for 18 frail elders who reside in Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach 19 Counties. The agency may seek any necessary waiver or state plan 20 amendments to implement this section.
