- Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 943.1718, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (e), and a new paragraph (d) is added to that subsection, to read: 943.1718 Body cameras; policies and procedures.—
- (2) A law enforcement agency that permits its law enforcement officers to wear body cameras shall establish policies and procedures addressing the proper use, maintenance, and storage of body cameras and the data recorded by body cameras. The policies and procedures must include:
- (d) General guidelines authorizing a law enforcement

 officer using a body camera during an incident to review the

 relevant video footage of the incident from the camera before

 writing a report on or providing a statement about the incident.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
