I of the State Constitution and may be used only 24 for purposes of voter registration: 25 (a) All declinations to register to vote made pursuant to

- (b) Information relating to the place where a person registered to vote or where a person updated a voter registration.
- (c) The social security number, driver license number, and Florida identification number of a voter registration applicant or voter.
- (d) All information concerning preregistered voter registration applicants who are 16 or 17 years of age. This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2022, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.
- (3) This section applies to information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of this exemption.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that all information concerning preregistered voter registration applicants who are 16 or 17 years of age which is held by an agency, and obtained for the purpose of voter registration, be confidential and exempt from public records requirements and be used only for purposes of voter registration. Information concerning preregistered 16-year-old and 17-year-old voter registration applicants could be misused if released. Minors are more vulnerable members of society, and the widespread release of information acquired through

preregistration activities may be used to solicit, harass, stalk, or intimidate such individuals. Without such protection, a minor may be less likely to take advantage of preregistering to vote, thus hindering the effective and efficient administration of a program that otherwise encourages greater participation in the democratic process.
