A bill to be entitled

An act relating to parking spaces for expectant mothers; creating s. 316.1966, F.S.; requiring certain parking lots to contain parking spaces designated for use by expectant mothers; requiring the Department of Transportation to establish requirements for signage and markings; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 316.1966, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

316.1966 Parking spaces for expectant mothers.—

- (1) The parking lot of a retail establishment or shopping center which contains more than 100 parking spaces must include at least one parking space that is designated for use by expectant mothers. Such a parking space must be located as closely as possible to parking spaces designated for use by persons with disabilities as provided in s. 553.5041; however, the location of parking spaces designated for use by persons with disabilities shall take precedence.
- (2) The Department of Transportation shall establish requirements for signage and markings used by the retail establishment or shopping center to designate parking spaces for use by expectant mothers as provided in subsection (1).
