House Resolution

A resolution recognizing April 2017 as "Prostate Cancer Awareness Month" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, other than skin cancer, prostate cancer is the 6 most common cancer among American men, with an estimated 180,890 7 new cases in 2016, and

8 WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates that nearly 9 27,000 Americans will die from prostate cancer in 2017, with 10 African American men more than twice as likely to die of 11 prostate cancer as white men, and

12 WHEREAS, while the risk of developing prostate cancer 13 increases exponentially as men age, almost 100 percent of 14 prostate cancer cases are curable with treatment, and

15 WHEREAS, there is a direct correlation between the 16 reduction of late-stage prostate cancers and increase in 17 Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA) testing, such that the expansion 18 of PSA testing may be credited for a 40 percent drop in 19 mortality rates associated with prostate cancer compared to the 20 early 1990s, and

21 WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society recommends that men 22 make an informed decision about whether to be screened for 23 prostate cancer after discussing information about the 24 uncertainties, risks, and potential benefits of prostate cancer 25 screening with their health care providers, NOW, THEREFORE,
