A bill to be entitled

An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 787.062, F.S.; creating the Florida Compensation Trust Fund for Survivors of Human Trafficking within the Department of Law Enforcement; providing the purpose of the trust fund and sources of funds; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 787.062, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

787.062 The Florida Compensation Trust Fund for Survivors of Human Trafficking.—

(2) The trust fund is established to receive and administer funds from civil actions brought on behalf of the trust fund, including, but not limited to, money from seizures of personal and real property, penalties imposed by the courts, or funds received from any other public or private sources or from the Legislature. The trust fund's purpose is to administer claims for compensation for survivors of human trafficking and to create a public-private partnership by establishing a not-for-profit foundation for receipt of charitable contributions to carry out the foundation's purposes, including, but not limited to:

(a) Educating the public about the recruitment,

trafficking, and exploitation of persons in connection with
human trafficking;

- (b) Assisting in the prevention of recruitment of minors in Florida schools for exploitation;
- (c) Establishment of a survivor's resource center for legal services, social services, safe harbors, safe houses, and language services that are available to survivors of human trafficking;
- (d) Advertising the National Human Trafficking Resource

 Center hotline number and the BeFree Textline in diverse venues;
- (e) Assisting in the coordination between law enforcement and service providers; and
- (f) Assisting in vacating any convictions of minors who were victims of human trafficking.
- (3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2021. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).
- Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, if SB or similar legislation is adopted in the same legislative session, or an extension thereof, and becomes law.
