license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "SaveOurLighthouses.org Visit Our Lights" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(84) DUCKS UNLIMITED LICENSE PLATES.-

- (a) The department shall develop a Ducks Unlimited license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. Ducks
  Unlimited license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Conserving Florida
  Wetlands" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
- (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used as follows:
- 1. Up to 5 percent may be used for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
- 2. A minimum of 95 percent shall be used in Florida to support the mission and efforts of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., to conserve, restore, and manage Florida's wetlands and associated habitats for the benefit of waterfowl, other wildlife, and people.
  - Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
