- (b) A bicycle sharing company must provide to users:
- 1. Notification that bicycles must be operated in compliance with state and local law.
- 2. Contact information that enables a user to notify the bicycle sharing company of an issue relating to the safety or maintenance of a bicycle.
- (c) A bicycle sharing company is responsible for the maintenance and rebalancing of each bicycle made available for rental or lease and for the removal of any such bicycle that is for any reason inoperable or does not comply with subsection (3).
- (d) A bicycle sharing company is responsible for securing all company bicycles located within any area of the state where an active tropical storm or hurricane warning has been issued. A local governmental entity may issue a bicycle sharing company a fine no greater than \$1,000 for failure to comply with this paragraph.
  - (5) PREEMPTION.—
- (a) A local governmental entity may not take any action or adopt any local ordinance, policy, or regulation that is designed to limit or prevent a bicycle sharing company or any
