An act relating to electric vehicle charging stations; amending s. 318.18, F.S.; specifying a noncriminal fine for the unlawful parking of a vehicle in an electric vehicle charging station; amending s. 366.94, F.S.; revising the penalties for the unlawful parking of a vehicle in an electric vehicle charging station; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 318.18, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

318.18 Amount of penalties.—The penalties required for a noncriminal disposition pursuant to s. 318.14 or a criminal offense listed in s. 318.17 are as follows:

- (2) Thirty dollars for all nonmoving traffic violations and:
- (a) For all violations of ss. 322.19 or 366.94 s. 322.19.
 Section 2. Paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section
 366.94, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

366.94 Electric vehicle charging stations.-

(3)

(b) If a law enforcement officer finds a motor vehicle in violation of this subsection, the officer or specialist shall charge the operator or other person in charge of the vehicle in violation with a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as provided in $\underline{s. 318.18(2)}$ $\underline{s. 316.008(4)}$ or $\underline{s. 318.18}$.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
