Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 877.19, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

877.19 Hate Crimes Reporting Act.-

(2) ACQUISITION AND PUBLICATION OF DATA.—The Governor, through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, shall collect and disseminate data on incidents of criminal acts that evidence prejudice based on race, religion, ethnicity, color, ancestry, sexual orientation, or national origin, or political affiliation or beliefs. All law enforcement agencies shall report monthly to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement concerning such offenses in such form and in such manner as prescribed by rules adopted by the department. Such information shall be compiled by the department and disseminated upon request to any local law enforcement agency, unit of local government, or state agency.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
