An act relating to dentistry; requiring

An act relating to dentistry; requiring the Department of Health to conduct a study on the affordability, access, and delivery of dental care in this state; requiring the department to submit a report on the findings of the study to the Governor and Legislature by a specified date; providing for expiration of the study; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Study on affordability, access, and delivery of dental care.—
- (1) The Department of Health shall conduct a comprehensive study on the status of affordability, access, and delivery of dental care in this state. The study must:
- (a) Examine utilization data and delivery system gaps, including demographic and income disparities.
- (b) Develop and evaluate policy proposals to address barriers to care, expedience of care delivery, and oral health outcomes for high-need and high-risk populations. Policy proposals must be peer-reviewed and address evidence of clinical outcomes and measures for increasing access to dental care for unserved or underserved populations.
 - (c) Examine workforce policies authorizing or increasing

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- (2) The department shall submit a report on the findings of the study that includes recommendations on improving the affordability, access, and delivery of dental care in this state to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by December 31, 2018. The report must address any implementation burdens and the sustainability of each policy recommendation.
 - (3) This act shall expire on January 31, 2019.
 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
