A bill to be entitled

An act relating to alternative high school graduation requirements; amending s. 1003.4282, F.S.; providing that, as of a specified school year, certain students are eligible for alternative pathways to a standard high school diploma; specifying the alternative pathways; requiring that students provide verified documentation of completion of the alternative pathway; requiring district school boards to incorporate certain information in the student progression plan; amending s. 1008.22, F.S.; providing that certain students may be eligible to complete an alternative pathway to a standard high school diploma; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsection (11) of section 1003.4282, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (12), and a new subsection (11) is added to that section, to read:

1003.4282 Requirements for a standard high school diploma.—
(11) ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS TO A STANDARD HIGH SCHOOL

23 DIPLOMA.-

(a) Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, a student who completed the minimum high school graduation course credit requirements established by rule of the State Board of Education but did not pass the grade 10 ELA assessment or the statewide, standardized Algebra I EOC assessment is eligible to complete an alternative pathway to a standard high school diploma.

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(b) A student may satisfy the requirements for a standard high school diploma through one of the following alternative pathways:

- 1. Attain an industry-recognized credential or certification approved by the State Board of Education and accumulate a combined level score of at least 13 points on the ACT WorkKeys Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information assessments.
- 2. Master the academic standards or competencies that had not previously been met, as indicated by the student not passing the applicable grade 10 ELA assessment or the statewide, standardized Algebra I EOC assessment, in a portfolio containing quantifiable evidence of such mastery.
- (c) A student shall be awarded a standard high school diploma upon completion of the requirements of an appropriate alternative pathway to graduation. The student must provide documentation verifying the completion of the alternative pathway to graduation. Documentation must be verified by the student's principal.
- (d) Each district school board shall incorporate the alternative pathways to graduation in the student progression plan required pursuant to s. 1008.25.
- Section 2. Present subsections (11), (12), and (13) of section 1008.22, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (12), (13), and (14), respectively, and a new subsection (11) is added to that section, to read:
 - 1008.22 Student assessment program for public schools.—
- (11) ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS TO GRADUATION.—If a student fails to satisfy the grade 10 ELA assessment or Algebra I EOC
