1 House Memorial 2 A memorial to the Congress of the United States, 3 urging Congress to adopt national standards for background screening of families hosting foreign 4 5 exchange students in the United States and for 6 programs sending students from the United States to 7 study abroad. 8 9 WHEREAS, in 2009 in Scranton, Pennsylvania, a number of 10 foreign exchange students were found to be suffering from 11 malnourishment or living in filthy, cramped host homes and had 12 to be removed from those homes, and 13 WHEREAS, in June 2017, a Cutler Bay, Florida man with a 14 prior felony conviction for a sexual assault was charged with numerous offenses stemming from allegations that he had seduced 15 16 and married a Spanish exchange student living in his home and used her to lure her underage sister to his home where she was 17 18 sexually abused, and 19 WHEREAS, critics of foreign exchange programs say weak regulatory oversight, combined with inferior industry practices 20 21 and a shortage of qualified host families, have led to neglect 22 and mental, physical, and sexual abuse of foreign exchange students, and 23 WHEREAS, a 2012 report of the United States Department of 24
