39 "Sexually cyberharass" means to publish to an Internet (C) website or disseminate through electronic means to another 40 41 person a sexually explicit image of a person that contains or 42 conveys the personal identification information of the depicted 43 person to an Internet website without the depicted person's 44 consent, contrary to the depicted person's reasonable 45 expectation that the image would remain private, for no 46 legitimate purpose, with the intent of causing substantial 47 emotional distress to the depicted person.
