An act relating to students leaving school grounds; amending s. 1001.43, F.S.; authorizing district school boards to adopt programs and policies for students to leave school grounds during their school lunch periods; requiring the parents of students in certain school districts to provide written consent for their children to leave school grounds during their school

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 1001.43, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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1001.43 Supplemental powers and duties of district school board.—The district school board may exercise the following supplemental powers and duties as authorized by this code or State Board of Education rule.

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(1) STUDENT MANAGEMENT.—The district school board may adopt programs and policies to ensure the safety and welfare of individuals, the student body, and school personnel, which programs and policies may:

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(c) Provide procedures for student dismissal precautions and for granting permission for students to leave school grounds during school hours, including releasing a student from school

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upon request by a parent, or for public appearances of school groups, or for his or her school lunch period. However, if a school district has more than 100,000 students enrolled in prekindergarten through grade 12, a parent must provide written consent for his or her child to be permitted to leave school grounds during his or her school lunch period.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

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
