(3) Each application for initial registration and renewal registration for participation in the state hemp program must be accompanied by a fee to be specified by department rule, not to exceed \$500 per application. The department may waive payment of the fee by rule. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the Plant Industry Trust Fund.
