A district school board or a Florida College System institution may not limit the number of students who enter dual enrollment programs, including early college acceleration programs under s. 1007.273, unless the commissioner grants a request for a 1-year waiver due to capacity to offer a quality program. (15)The Department of Education shall develop a statement on transfer guarantees to inform students and their parents, prior to enrollment in a dual enrollment course, of the potential for the dual enrollment course to articulate as an elective or a general education course into a postsecondary education certificate or degree program. This statement shall include the English and mathematics courses that require a grade of C or higher to measure student achievement in college-level communication and computation skills, pursuant to state board rule. The statement shall be provided to each district school superintendent, who shall include the statement in the information provided to all secondary students and their parents as required pursuant to this subsection.
