An act relating to sexual misconduct; creating s. 1004.098, F.S.; defining terms; requiring that a postsecondary educational institution include a notation on a student's academic transcript if the student has been dismissed from the institution for a sexual misconduct offense; requiring that the institution notify the student of such notation; requiring that institutions adopt procedures for removing a notation from a student's academic transcript under certain circumstances; requiring that an institution remove the notation on a student's academic transcript if the student fulfills certain requirements; specifying a requirement for the notation delineating a sexual misconduct offense on a student's academic transcript; requiring the State Board of Education to adopt rules and the Board of Governors to adopt regulations; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Section 1004.098, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

(1) DEFINITIONS.—As used in this section, the term:

(a) "Postsecondary educational institution" means a Florida

College System institution, a state university, or an independent college or university that is eligible to participate in the William L. Boyd, IV, Effective Access to Student Education Grant Program under s. 1009.89.

- (b) "Sexual misconduct" means fondling the genital area, groin, inner thighs, buttocks, or breasts of a person; the oral, anal, or vaginal penetration by or union with the sexual organ of another; or the anal or vaginal penetration of another by any other object.
- (2) TRANSCRIPT NOTATION REQUIREMENT.—Each postsecondary educational institution shall:
- (a) Include a prominent notation on the academic transcript of each student who is permanently dismissed, pursuant to s.

 1006.60, for an offense involving sexual misconduct under the institution's code of conduct.
- (b) Notify the student that the permanent dismissal will be documented on the student's academic transcript.
- (3) NOTATION REMOVAL.—Each postsecondary educational institution shall:
- (a) Adopt a procedure in the institution's code of conduct for removing a notation delineating a sexual misconduct offense from the academic transcript of any student who is permanently dismissed and is subsequently found not to have committed the sexual misconduct offense.
- (b) Remove the notation for a sexual misconduct offense placed on a student's academic transcript if the student fulfills the conditions for removal pursuant to the postsecondary educational institution's notation removal procedure.

(4) NOTATION.—The notation delineating a sexual misconduct offense on a student's academic transcript must be in substantially the following form: "Dismissed for a sexual misconduct violation of (Name of institution's code of conduct)."

(5) RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.—The State Board of Education shall adopt rules, and the Board of Governors shall adopt regulations, consistent with this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
