At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 1747A, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 1747A, \$50,000 in nonrecurring funds from the General Revenue Fund is provided for the Leon County Orchard Pond Greenway Trail, Phase II (Senate Form 2119).
