17	377.19 Definitions.—As used in ss. 377.06, 377.07, and
18	377.10-377.40, the term:
19	(5) "Fracking" means all stages of well intervention
20	performed by injecting high volumes of fluids at a high rate
21	into a rock formation at pressures at or exceeding the fracture
22	gradient of the rock formation in order to propagate fractures.
23	The term does not include techniques used for conventional well
24	stimulation or conventional workover procedures; techniques used
25	for routine well cleanout work, well maintenance, or removal of

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formation damage due to drilling or production; or conventional 26 27 acidizing techniques used to enhance, maintain, or restore the 28 natural permeability of the formation. 29 (6) (5) "Gas" means all natural gas, including casinghead 30 gas, and all other hydrocarbons not defined as oil in subsection 31  $(16) \quad \frac{(15)}{(15)}$ 32 Section 2. Section 377.2405, Florida Statutes, is created 33 to read: 377.2405 Fracking; notification.-34 35 (1) PROHIBITION.-Fracking is prohibited in this state. A 36 permit for drilling or operating a well does not authorize 37 fracking. (2) NOTIFICATION. - An operator must provide written notice 38 to the department before using techniques for routine well 39 40 cleanout work, well maintenance, removal of formation damage due to drilling or production, or enhancing, maintaining, or 41 42 restoring the natural permeability of the formation. 43 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
