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13 (1)ESTABLISHMENT OF CLASS.-A separate class of membership within the Florida Retirement System, to be known as the 14 15 "Special Risk Class," is established to recognize that persons 16 employed in certain categories of law enforcement, firefighting, 17 criminal detention, and emergency medical care positions and 18 persons employed as guardians pursuant to s. 1006.12 are required as one of the essential functions of their positions to 19 20 perform work that is physically demanding or arduous, or work that requires extraordinary agility and mental acuity, and that 21 such persons, because of diminishing physical and mental 22 23 faculties, may find that they are not able, without risk to the health and safety of themselves, the public, or their coworkers, 24 25 to continue performing such duties and thus enjoy the full 26 career and retirement benefits enjoyed by persons employed in 27 other membership classes and that, if they find it necessary, due to the physical and mental limitations of their age, to 28 29 retire at an earlier age and usually with less service, they will suffer an economic deprivation therefrom. To address the 30 31 peculiar and special problems of this class of employees, a 32 class of retirement membership is established that awards more 33 retirement credit per year of service than that awarded to other employees; however, nothing contained herein shall require 34 35 ineligibility for Special Risk Class membership upon reaching age 55. 36

37 (2) MEMBERSHIP.-

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38 Effective July 1, 2019, "special risk member" includes (h) 39 any member who meets the special criteria for continued 40 membership set forth in paragraph (3)(j). (i) (h) Effective August 1, 2008, "special risk member" 41 42 includes any member who meets the special criteria for continued 43 membership set forth in paragraph (3)(k) $\frac{(3)(j)}{(3)(j)}$. 44 (3) CRITERIA.-A member, to be designated as a special risk 45 member, must meet the following criteria: (j) Effective July 1, 2019, the member must be employed by 46 a school board as a guardian pursuant to 1006.12; or 47 SPECIAL RISK ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT CLASS.-48 (8) 49 (a) A special risk member who is moved or reassigned to a nonspecial risk law enforcement, firefighting, correctional, or 50 emergency medical care administrative support position, or as a 51 52 guardian pursuant to s. 1006.12 with the same agency, or who is 53 subsequently employed in such a position within any law 54 enforcement, firefighting, correctional, or emergency medical 55 care, or educational agency under the Florida Retirement System, 56 shall participate in the Special Risk Administrative Support 57 Class and earn credit for such service at the same percentage 58 rate as that earned by a regular member. Notwithstanding subsection (5), service in an administrative support position, 59 for purposes of s. 121.091, applies toward satisfaction of the 60 special risk normal retirement date, as defined in s. 121.021, 61 if, while in such position, the member remains certified as a 62 935951

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63 law enforcement officer, firefighter, correctional officer, 64 emergency medical technician, or paramedic, or guardian; remains 65 subject to reassignment at any time to a position qualifying for 66 special risk membership; and completes an aggregate of the years 67 of service as a designated special risk member before retirement 68 which is equal to or greater than the years of service required 69 to be vested.
