in a secrecy envelope and thereafter sealed in a provisional 17 ballot envelope. The provisional ballot shall be deposited in a 18 19 ballot box. All provisional ballots shall remain sealed in their 20 envelopes for return to the supervisor of elections. The 21 department shall prescribe the form of the provisional ballot 22 envelope. A person casting a provisional ballot shall have the 23 right to present written evidence supporting his or her eligibility to vote to the supervisor of elections by not later 24 than 5 p.m. on the second day following the election. 25

The county canvassing board shall examine each 26 (2) (a) 27 Provisional Ballot Voter's Certificate and Affirmation to 28 determine if the person voting that ballot was entitled to vote 29 in the county at the precinct where the person cast a vote in 30 the election and that the person had not already cast a ballot in the election. In determining whether a person casting a 31 32 provisional ballot is entitled to vote, the county canvassing 33 board shall review the information provided in the Voter's Certificate and Affirmation, written evidence provided by the 34 35 person pursuant to subsection (1), any other evidence presented 36 by the supervisor of elections, and, in the case of a challenge, 37 any evidence presented by the challenger. A ballot of a person casting a provisional ballot shall be counted unless the 38 canvassing board determines by a preponderance of the evidence 39 that the person was not entitled to vote. 40
