A resolution designating April 16, 2019, as "Disability History and Awareness Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, approximately 12.8 percent of Florida's population are persons living with disabilities, and

WHEREAS, individuals and organizations work tirelessly throughout the state to bring awareness to persons with disabilities and the history of disability, and

WHEREAS, one such individual, Rebecca "Becki" M. Forsell, determinedly worked towards independence and empowerment for people living with disabilities since the onset of her own disability in 1996, and

WHEREAS, persons with disabilities regularly volunteer and give back to their communities through outreach programs, mentoring, tutoring, and peer support, and

WHEREAS, including persons with disabilities in classrooms to help create educational tools and training aids promotes better treatment of school-age children with disabilities and prevents bullying or harassment amongst peers, and

WHEREAS, increasing awareness of persons with disabilities and the history of disability may lead to increased possibilities of individuals with disabilities becoming an active part of their communities through proactive and positive
