6 Section 5. Subsection (5) of section 1004.085, Florida

10 (5) Each Florida College System institution and state
11 university board of trustees is authorized to adopt policies in
12 consultation with providers, including bookstores, which allow
13 for the use of innovative pricing techniques and payment options
14 for textbooks and instructional materials. Such policies may
15 include bulk pricing arrangements that enable students to
16 purchase course materials or texts that are delivered digitally;

17 delivered through other technologies that are, or the licenses
18 of which are, required for use within a course; or delivered in
19 a print format. Innovative pricing techniques and payment
20 options must include an opt-in or opt-out provision for students
21 and may be approved only if there is documented evidence that
22 the options reduce the cost of textbooks and instructional
23 materials for students taking a course.
