I.Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 - 288171 (body with title)

II.Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 removes the provision in the bill that would allow certain local governments to impose both a contribution requirement related to public education facilities and an education-related impact fee without any offsetting credit. In order to qualify, the local government must have been governed by a charter that was adopted and implemented before December 31, 2006, and the charter language must contain provisions for providing school capacity. Qualifying local governments must use the contributions related to public education facilities to fund impacts not otherwise funded by education-related impact fees.
