The Committee on Appropriations (Harrell) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

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Delete lines 68 - 73

4 and insert:

> maladaptive behaviors in this state. The agency may grant no more than three exemptions under this paragraph.

- 1. The exemption under this paragraph does not require a specific legislative appropriation.
- 2. An exemption under this paragraph shall terminate 18 months after the date of issuance unless the exemption holder



has commenced construction. The agency shall monitor the progress of the holder of the certificate of exemption in meeting the timetable for project development specified in the application for exemption. The agency shall extend the time period for a project if the exemption holder demonstrates to the satisfaction of the agency that good-faith commencement of the project is being delayed by litigation or by governmental action or inaction with respect to regulations or permitting precluding commencement of the project.

3. This paragraph and subsection (6) of s. 400.962 are repealed July 1, 2022, unless reviewed and saved from repeal by the Legislature.

Delete lines 9 - 13

27 and insert:

> limiting the number of such exemptions the Agency for Health Care Administration may grant; providing that a specific legislative appropriation is not required for the exemption; providing timeframes and a monitoring process for the exemptions granted by the agency; providing for future legislative review and repeal of the exemption; providing an effective date.
