Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (11) of section 381.0041, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

381.0041 Donation and transfer of human tissue; testing requirements.-

(11)

(b) Any person who has human immunodeficiency virus infection, who knows he or she is infected with human



immunodeficiency virus, and who has been informed that he or she may communicate this disease by donating blood, plasma, organs, skin, or other human tissue who donates blood, plasma, organs, skin, or other human tissue for use in another person commits is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. This paragraph does not apply if the donation is made specifically for a recipient who is infected with human immunodeficiency virus and who knows that the donor is infected with human immunodeficiency virus.
