Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (3) of section 556.101, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

556.101 Short title; legislative intent.-

- (3) It is the purpose of this chapter to:
- (d) Reserve to the state the power to regulate any subject matter specifically addressed in this chapter. Municipalities, counties, districts, or other local governments may not adopt or enforce ordinances or rules that conflict with this chapter or that prescribe either any of the following:
- 1. Require operators of underground facilities to obtain permits from local governments in order to identify underground facilities.
  - 2. Require premarking or marking.
- 3. Specify the types of paint or other marking devices that are used to identify underground facilities.
  - 4. Require removal of marks.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
