15	Section 1. Section 626.97075, Florida Statutes, is created		
16	to read:		
17	626.97075 Life insurance, disability insurance, and long-		
18	3 term care insurance; discrimination against living organ donors

20	(1) As used in this section, the term "policy" means any of		
21	the following:		
22	(a) An individual or group life insurance policy.		
23	(b) An industrial life insurance policy, as the term		
24	<u>"industrial life insurance" is defined in s. 627.502(1).</u>		
25	(c) A credit life insurance or credit disability insurance		
26	policy, as defined in s. 627.677(1) and (2), respectively.		
27	(d) A long-term care insurance policy as defined in s.		
28	<u>627.9404(1).</u>		
29	(2) Notwithstanding any other law, an insurer may not,		

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under a policy:		
(a) Decline or limit coverage of a person solely due to his		
or her status as a living organ donor;		
(b) Preclude an insured from donating all or part of an		
organ as a condition to continuing to receive coverage under the		
5 policy; or		
(c) Otherwise discriminate in the offering, issuance,		
7 cancellation, coverage, premium, or any other condition of the		
8 policy for a person without any additional actuarial risk and		
9 based solely on his or her status as a living organ donor.		
(3) The commission may adopt rules and take actions		
1 necessary to enforce this section.		
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.		

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
